FIRST AID

- Alliance Redwoods provides first aid staff who are available 24 hours/day.
- All medications, including inhalers, must be turned in to the camp medic on the first day, accompanied by a complete "Medication Check in" form **signed by a doctor**. This includes over the counter and prescribed medicines. The camp has all First Aid supplies (band aids, Tylenol, Advil, cough drops, etc).

PARENT CHAPERONES

- We will need parent volunteers for chaperones (one adult per every 7 children from Vallecito, Mary Silveira, and/or Dixie)
- Parent chaperones will not be in their own child's group, and mixing genders is not allowed in cabins.
- All chaperones need to be background checked by getting fingerprinted.
- Parent chaperones will attend for FREE!
- If you are interested in being a parent chaperone, please fill out the chaperone application. If more parents volunteer than needed, then a lottery will be done to choose which parents attend
- Don't forget your reusable mug for coffee and tea!
