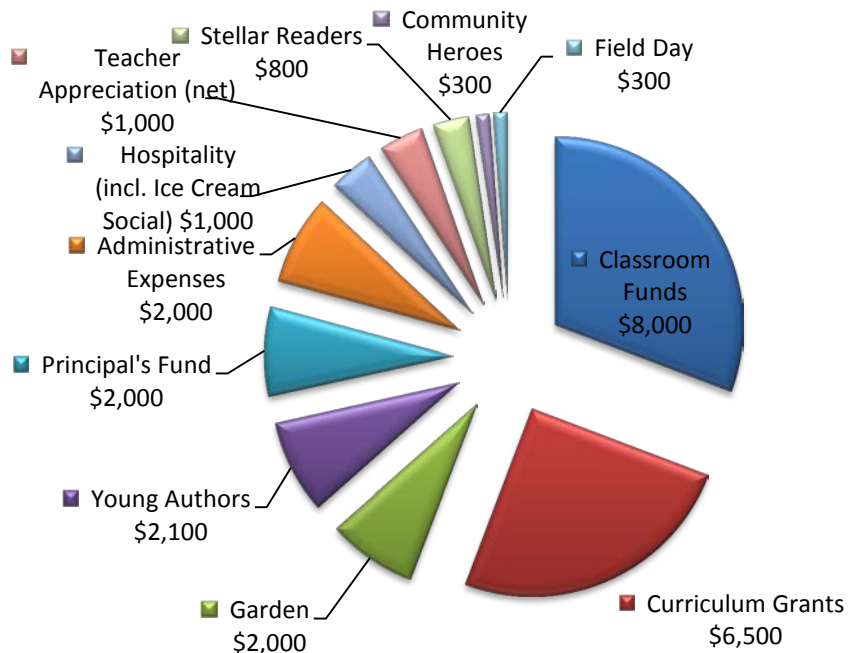

## March is Fundraising Kickoff Month!

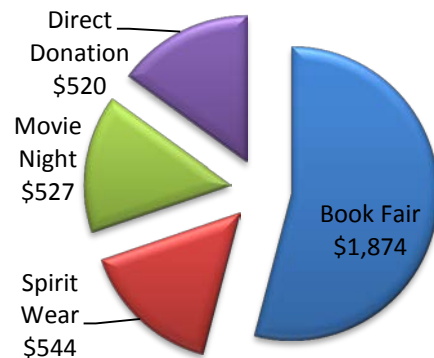
Hope you enjoyed your Mid-Winter Break. While you were away, your MESHSA team was busy brainstorming because **March is Fundraising Kick Off Month!**
